STRADA is the only European leadership programme designed for emerging women across manufacturing.

It originates from the alarming gender gap observed in the manufacturing sector. The programme aims to give participating women the skills and confidence they need to grow and accelerate their careers in manufacturing.

The programme is made of four components:

- Training course comprised of four themes: leadership, digitalisation, sustainability, entrepreneurship and innovation.
- 1-1 mentoring sessions
- Networking opportunities, expert webinars, workshops and Tech café.
